Minimum: High School Diploma or equivalent and Preschool CDA or North Carolina Early Childhood Credential, ITS-SIDS or the ability to obtain within 90 days of employment, able to complete North Carolina Health and Safety Training Requirements, 1-year experience working with children, good oral, written and organizational skills, and reliable transportation.

DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Responsible for maintaining center compliance (Star Rated License, NC Child Care Rules, Head Start Program Performance Standards, and other regulation/Policies & Procedures) as part of the teaching team
2. Responsible for supervising children and maintaining staff-child ratio at all times
3. Assist with preparing materials and activities for individuals, small and large groups of children in accordance with curriculum
4. Responsible for serving as Lead Teacher or teacher in their absence as requested by the On-Site Administrator, Education Manager or Director of Children's Services
5. Responsible for serving as an advocate for children and families in the community
6. Promote the development of secure relationships with infant/toddlers assigned by assuring primary and continuity of care
7. To attend mandatory local and out of town workshops, conferences and training sessions as required to enhance job skills. Responsible for feeding and diapering infants/toddlers according to their individual schedule, holding them every time they are fed and sharing information about their eating with their parents daily through a written daily report
8. Responsible for ensuring child's individual sleep patterns are recognized and responded to as needed
9. Responsible for attending Head Start/Early Head Start functions in which some activities may take place after Head Start/Early Head Start regular operational hours
10. Responsible for encouraging children to participate fully in all activities at all levels of interest and ability
