<u>Minimum:</u> High School Diploma or equivalent and Preschool CDA or North Carolina Early Childhood Credential, ITS-SIDS or the ability to obtain within 90 days of employment, able to complete North Carolina Health and Safety Training Requirements, 1-year experience working with children, good oral, written and organizational skills, and reliable transportation.

DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Responsible for maintaining center compliance (Star Rated License, NC Child Care Rules, Head Start Program Performance Standards, and other regulation/Policies & Procedures) as part of the teaching team
- 2. Responsible for supervising children and maintaining staff-child ratio at all times
- 3. Assist with preparing materials and activities for individuals, small and large groups of children in accordance with curriculum
- 4. Responsible for serving as Lead Teacher or teacher in their absence as requested by the On-Site Administrator, Education Manager or Director of Children's Services
- 5. Responsible for serving as an advocate for children and families in the community
- 6. Promote the development of secure relationships with infant/toddlers assigned by assuring primary and continuity of care
- 7. To attend mandatory local and out of town workshops, conferences and training sessions as required to enhance job skills. Responsible for feeding and diapering infants/toddlers according to their individual schedule, holding them every time they are fed and sharing information about their eating with their parents daily through a written daily report
- 8. Responsible for ensuring child's individual sleep patterns are recognized and responded to as needed
- 9. Responsible for attending Head Start/Early Head Start functions in which some activities may take place after Head Start/Early Head Start regular operational hours
- 10. Responsible for encouraging children to participate fully in all activities at all levels of interest and ability
