



# Put Weatherization to Work for You!

## What is Weatherization?

The Weatherization Assistance Program (WAP) is the nation's core program for delivering *energy efficiency services* to low-income households. The program is administered through the U.S. Department of Energy and the NC Department of Environmental Quality. The Weatherization Assistance Program is designed to help low-income citizens save energy and reduce expenses through the installation of energy conservation materials, the implementation of energy efficient measures in their homes and energy education. **HARRP is a Heating Appliance Repair and Replacement Program** that works in concert with the Weatherization Assistance Program to repair and/or replace inefficient heating and air systems. Professionally trained weatherization crews perform on-site home energy audits using state of the art equipment to identify outside drafts and inspect heating and cooling systems for efficiency. Weatherization crews install insulation, seal off air leaks, make modifications to (or replace) existing heating systems, and make minor repairs to ensure safety. Once installed, these energy saving measures help to reduce heating and cooling costs for years to come.

## Do I qualify for services?

*Do I have to own my own home to qualify for services?*

You don't have to own your own home to qualify. You may qualify whether you own or rent, live in a single-family home, multifamily complex or in a mobile home.

*Do I have to be a certain age or meet an income guideline to qualify?*

While preference is given to persons over 60, persons with disabilities and in some cases, children; if you receive Supplemental Security Income (SSI) and/or Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF), you are automatically eligible. You may also be eligible for assistance if your income meets the following federally established annual income guidelines:
