Eligibility	Age: Children must be between ages 1-4 Income: I-CARE, Inc. Utilizes the Federal Poverty guidelines published each year. Families who are at or below the guidelines will be selected first. Family Situation: Families experiencing homelessness or children in foster care will be selected first. Disability and/or Delay: Children with a diagnosed disability, delay, or suspected delay will be given priority points to provide a continuum of services with local providers and local school systems.
Selection Process	Upon receipt of required documentation, your child's application will go through a Selection Criteria process. The child will then be enrolled, if an opening is available, or placed on the waiting list if there are no openings. Completion of the application and submission of required documents does not guarantee enrollment into the HS/EHS program. Families will be notified by phone and letter whether their child will be enrolled or placed on the waiting list.
Fees	There is no cost to attend Head Start or Early Head Start There is no cost for meals served (breakfast, lunch, snack)
Calendar	Same as Local Education Agency (subject to change)
Before and After School Care	Provided at Southeast Child Development Center (private pay and DSS voucher program only) Provided at First Class Preparatory School for Mooresville Head Start (private pay and DSS voucher program only)
Classroom Learning Environment	Some learning environments for preschoolers will have combination (3/4-year old's), 3-year-old, and 4-year-old classrooms. For 1- to 3-year-olds, children will be in a small learning group of no more than 8 children with varying ages. All learning environments will make accommodation (if applicable) to the needs of specific populations (disabilities, foster care, and homelessness, etc.)
